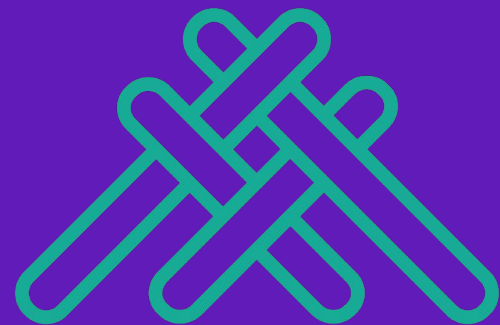

This textile academy bootcamp is an preliminary testdrive of a new course starting in September 2017, the FABRICADEMY

The format and concept will be based on the fab academy or the bioacademy with a duration of 14 classes (3-5 months and 2-5 months of project development) We open the course to institutions and schools, maker spaces, independent groups, fab labs, camps. 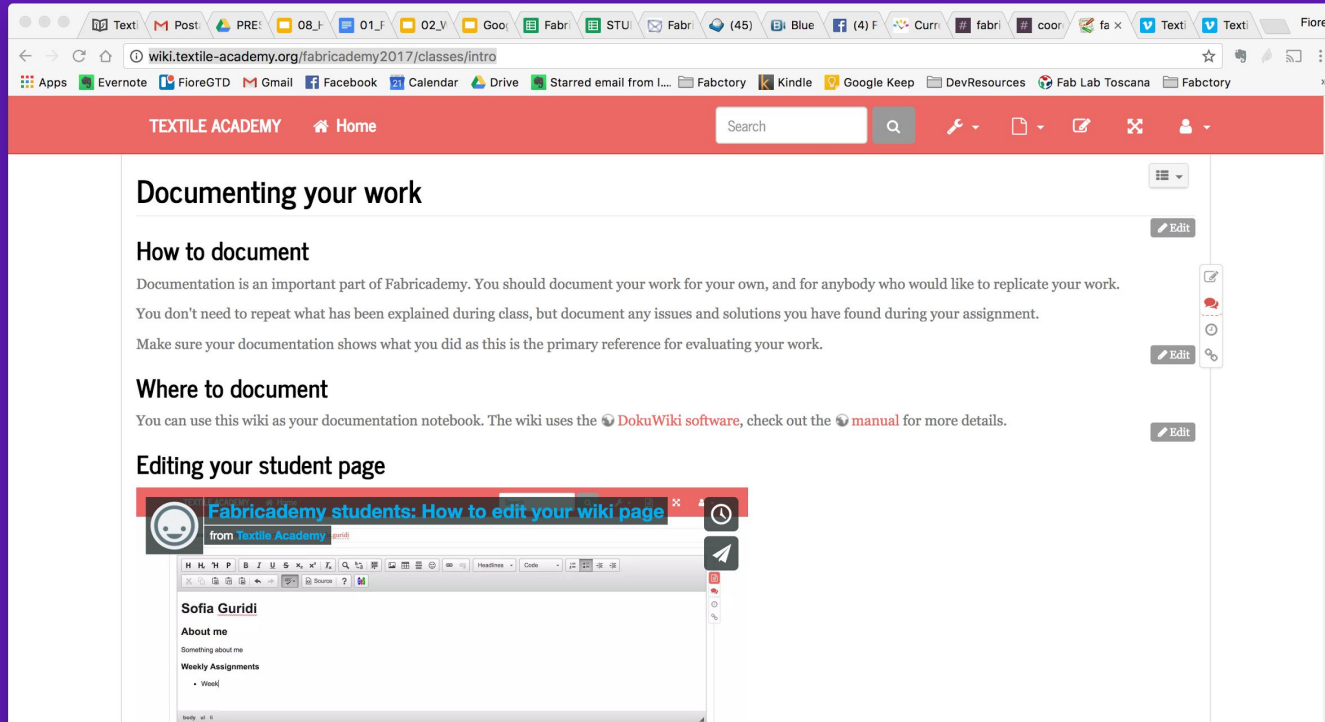
